ORDINANCE NO. 773

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD, NEBRASKA, AMENDING SPRINGFIELD MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 10-118; PROHIBITING THE OFF-PREMISES SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES BEYOND 1:00 A.M.; AUTHORIZING THE ON-PREMISES SALE AND DISPENSING OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES UNTIL 2:00 A.M.; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND REPEALING ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD, NEBRASKA

Section 1. Section 10-118 of the Municipal Code of Springfield, Nebraska is amended to read as follows:

§10-118 ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES; HOURS OF SALE. It shall be unlawful for any licensed person or persons or their agents to sell any alcoholic beverages within the Municipality except during the hours provided herein:

HOURS OF SALE

Alcoholic Liquors (except beer and win)

Secular Days

Off Sale 6:00 A.M. to 1:00 A.M.
On Sale..... 6:00 A.M. to 2:00 A.M.

Sundays

Off Sale 12:00 Noon to 1:00 A.M.
On Sale..... 12:00 Noon to 2:00 A.M.

Beer and Wine

Secular Days

Off Sale 6:00 A.M. to 1:00 A.M.
On Sale..... 6:00 A.M. to 2:00 A.M.

Sundays

Off Sale 6:00 A.M. to 1:00 A.M.
On Sale..... 6:00 A.M. to 2:00 A.M.

Provided that such limitations shall not apply after twelve o'clock (12:00) Noon on Sunday to a licensee which is a nonprofit corporation holding a license pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. 53-124-(5)(C) & (E).

No person or persons shall consume any alcoholic beverages on licensed premises for a period of time longer than fifteen (15) minutes after the time fixed herein for stopping the sale of alcoholic beverages on the said premises. For the purposes of this section, "on sale" shall be defined as alcoholic beverages sold by the drink for consumption on the premises of the licensed

establishment; "off sale" shall be defined as alcoholic beverages sold at retail in the original container for consumption off the premises of the licensed establishment.

Nothing in this section shall be construed to prohibit licensed premises from being open for business on days and hours during which the sale or dispensing of alcoholic beverages is prohibited by this section.

Section 2. Any other ordinance or section passed and approved prior to passage, approval and publication or posting of this ordinance and in conflict with its provisions is repealed.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force on the latter of July 15, 2010, or after passage, approval and publication as provided by law.


