ORDER

Now on the 7<sup>th</sup> day of June 2016, this matter came on for consideration before the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission, the licensee having executed a voluntary appearance, waiver of public hearing, plea of guilty, and consent to judgment, in regard to the charge filed on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of May 2016.

Upon consideration of all the evidence in this case, the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission finds:

1. That the licensee did, on or about December 31, 2015 permit the selling, dispensing, or giving away of alcoholic liquor, to or for an individual being less than 21 years of age, in violation of Neb. Rev. Stat. Sec. 53-180 and/or 237-LCC6-019.01A of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission
2. That the license shall be suspended for a mandatory period of two (2) days and that the license should be suspended for an additional thirty (30) days, with the option to pay a fine in lieu thereof.
3. That the licensee and all staff shall complete an approved alcohol server training program within sixty (60) days from the date of this Order and shall show certification with complying with the provision of 237-LCC14-004 of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.

IT IS THEREFORE CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Retail Class CK Liquor License of Mya M Walker, DBA – "Paddington Station", 308 East N Street, Orleans, Nebraska, should be, and the same hereby is, suspended, suspended for a period of two (2) mandatory closure days and suspended an additional thirty (30) days, with the option to pay a fine in lieu thereof, such mandatory closure to be August 1, 2016 and August 2, 2016; and the additional thirty (30) day suspension to commence at the closing hour of business on the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of August 2016, and to continue until the opening hour of business on the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of September 2016. Additionally, that the licensee and all staff shall complete an approved alcohol server training program within sixty (60) days from the date of this Order and shall show certification with complying with the provision of 237-LCC14-004 of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the notice of suspension shall be posted upon the premises, said notice to remain posted throughout the term of said suspension.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Licensee shall pay costs of this action, assessed in the amount of \$0.00.
