ORDER

Now on the 3rd day of August 2021, this matter came on for consideration before the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission upon a request for reconsideration/rehearing having been filed by Jose and Theresa Palomares, dba "Paleteria Y Restaurant San Luis", 4802 S 24th Street, Omaha, Nebraska, said license having been previously cancelled by this Commission in Order dated August 16, 2021.

The licensee was present. The Commission was represented by Milissa Johnson-Wiles, Assistant Attorney General.

Upon opening of the hearing, the licensee entered a plea of guilty to the charge.

1. That the Order of cancellation should be rescinded.
2. That the licensee did purchase, receive, acquire, accept or possess alcoholic liquors from persons not authorized to sell to the licensee.
3. That the license should be suspended for a period of fifteen (15) days, with the option to pay a fine in lieu thereof.
4. That the licensee and all staff shall complete an approved alcohol server training program within sixty (60) days from the date of this Order and shall show certification with complying with the provision of 237-LCC14-004 of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.
5. That the alcohol seized during this investigation shall be destroyed by the Nebraska State Patrol in accordance with Neb. Rev. Stat. 53-1,113.

IT IS THEREFORE CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Retail Class CK Liquor License of Jose and Teresa Palomares, DBA – "Paleteria Y Restaurant San Luis", 4802 S 24th Street, Omaha, Nebraska, should be, and the same hereby is, suspended for a period of fifteen (15) days, such suspension to commence at the closing hour of business on the 12th day of December 2021, and to continue until the opening hour of business on the 28th day of December 2021, with the option to pay a fine in lieu thereof. Additionally, that the licensee and all staff shall complete an approved alcohol server training program within sixty (60) days from the date of this Order and shall show certification with complying with the provision of 237-LCC14-004 of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission. Furthermore, That the alcohol seized during this investigation shall be destroyed by the Nebraska State Patrol in accordance with Neb. Rev. Stat. 53-1,113.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the notice of suspension shall be posted upon the premises, said notice to remain posted throughout the term of said suspension.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Licensee shall pay costs of this action, assessed in the amount of \$35.00 and the Licensee shall pay costs of \$35.00 as previously referenced in Ordered dated August 16, 2021.
