Now on the 12<sup>th</sup> day of October, 2016, this matter came on for hearing before the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission upon an order to show cause why the license should not be suspended, cancelled or revoked for failing to file a manager's application with the Commission within the required time, in violation of 237-LCC2-009.01 of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission. Additionally, for failure of Colleen Lecher to superintend the day to day operations of the business.

The licensee was present and represented by attorney Bradley Sipp. The Commission was represented by Milissa Johnson-Wiles, Assistant Attorney General.

Upon consideration of the all the evidence in this matter, the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission finds:


1. That the licensee is surrendering its Retail Class I-105943 Liquor License of Panhandle Event Center, 247 Bordeauz Street, Chadron, Nebraska.
2. That the license should be, and the same hereby is, cancelled, effective immediately.

IT IS THEREFORE CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Retail Class I-105943 Liquor License of Panhandle Center LLC dba "Panhandle Event Center", located at 247 Bordeauz Street, Chadron, Nebraska, should be, and the same hereby is, cancelled, effective immediately.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the licensee shall pay costs of this action, assessed in the amount of \$674.84.
