ORDER

Now on the 7th day of September 2016, this matter came on for consideration before the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission, the licensee having executed a voluntary appearance, waiver of public hearing, plea of guilty, and consent to judgment, in regard to the charge filed on the 20th day of July 2016.

Upon consideration of all the evidence in this case, the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission finds:

1. That the licensee did, on or about February 14, 2016, permit open containers of alcoholic liquor to remain or to be in possession or control of persons for the purposes of consumption after 1:15 a.m., in violation of Neb. Rev. Stat. Sec. 53-179(3) and/or 237-LCC6-019.01D of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.
2. That the license should be suspended for a period of five (5) days, with the option to pay a fine in lieu thereof.

IT IS THEREFORE CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Retail Class I Liquor License of Paradise Club LLC, DBA – “Paradise Dance Club”, 4704 Howard Blvd, Columbus, Nebraska, should be, and the same hereby is, suspended for a period of five (5) days, such suspension to commence at the closing hour of business on the 30th day of October 2016, and to continue until the opening hour of business on the 5th day of November 2016, with the option to pay a fine in lieu thereof.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the notice of suspension shall be posted upon the premises, said notice to remain posted throughout the term of said suspension.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Licensee shall pay costs of this action, assessed in the amount of \$18.50.

IMPORTANT - PLEASE READ

To Licensee:

The Order of suspension, to which this Notice is enclosed, provides for a suspension of your license for a period of **five (5)** days. State Law provides that you may either comply with the Order of suspension and be closed for the prescribed number of days or you may notify the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission and elect to pay a fine of **\$50** per day for the number of days of your suspension and remain open and continue the full operation of your establishment.

If you desire to pay a fine instead of being closed you must sign the below election notification request and mail it to the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission, P.O. Box 95046, Lincoln, Nebraska 68509, along with a certified or cashier's check, personal or business check, or U.S. money order made payable to the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission; the election notification must be received by the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission on or before **October 24, 2016**; if the election notification and full payment is not received by the above stated date then you must close your establishment for the sale of alcoholic liquor for the required number of days suspended.
