Now on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of January, 2016, this matter came on for hearing before the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission, notice having been served upon the licensee to appear and respond to an administrative citation alleging that the license should be suspended, cancelled or revoked as more fully set out herein.

The licensee was present and represented by attorney Perry Pirsch. The Commission was represented by Milissa Johnson-Wiles, Assistant Attorney General.

FINDINGS OF FACT:

1. That the licensee did, on or about September 15, 2015, permit or knowingly allow conduct on or about the licensed premise, i.e., felony assault.

CONCLUSION OF LAW:


1. That permitting or knowingly allowing conduct on or about the licensed premise is in direct violation of 237-LCC6-019.01Q of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.
2. That the license should be cancelled.

IT IS THEREFORE CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Retail Class C-110664 Liquor License of Holt Enterprises LLC, dba "Paul's Pub", at 5250 Cornhusker Hwy., Lincoln, Nebraska, should be, and the same hereby is, cancelled, effective at the closing hour of business on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2016.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the licensee shall pay costs of this action, assessed in the amount of \$25.00.
