ORDER

Now on the 1st day of March 2022, this matter came on for consideration before the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission, the licensee having executed a voluntary appearance, waiver of public hearing, plea of guilty, and consent to judgment, in regard to the charge filed on the 4th day of February 2022.

Upon consideration of all the evidence in this case, the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission finds:

1. That the licensee did, on or about December 18, 2021, permit the selling, dispensing, or giving away of alcoholic liquor, to or for an individual being less than 21 years of age, in violation of Neb. Rev. Stat. Sec. 53-180 and/or 237-LCC6-019.01A of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.
2. That the license shall be suspended for a mandatory period of two (2) days and that the license should be suspended for an additional fifty (50) days, with the option to pay a fine in lieu thereof.
3. That the licensee and all staff shall complete an approved alcohol server training program within sixty (60) days from the date of this Order and shall show certification with complying with the provision of 237-LCC14-004 of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.

IT IS THEREFORE CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Retail Class D Liquor License of Nisor Inc DBA – “Petromart”, 6508 John J Pershing Dr, Omaha, Nebraska, should be, and the same hereby is, suspended for a period of two (2) mandatory closure days and suspended an additional fifty (50) days, with the option to pay a fine in lieu thereof, such mandatory closure to be April 18th, 2022 and April 19th, 2022; and the additional fifty (50) day suspension to commence on April 20th, 2022, and to continue until the opening hour of business on the 9th day of June 2022. Additionally, that the licensee and all staff shall complete an approved alcohol server training program within sixty (60) days from the date of this Order and shall show certification with complying with the provision of 237-LCC14-004 of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the notice of suspension shall be posted upon the premises, said notice to remain posted throughout the term of said suspension.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Licensee shall pay costs of this action, assessed in the amount of \$0.00.


