**ORDER**

Now on the 11th day of July 2023, this matter came on for consideration before the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission, the licensee having executed a voluntary appearance, waiver of public hearing, plea of guilty, and consent to judgment, in regard to the charge filed on the 19th day of May 2023.

Upon consideration of all the evidence in this case, the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission finds:

1. That the licensee did, on or about January 11, 2022, sell and/or deliver alcoholic liquor for resale to unauthorized persons/licenses in violation of the Neb. Rev. Stat. Sec. 53-176 of the Nebraska Liquor Control Act.
2. That the licensee did, on or about January 14, 2022, sell and/or deliver alcoholic liquor for resale to unauthorized persons/licenses in violation of the Neb. Rev. Stat. Sec. 53-176 of the Nebraska Liquor Control Act.
3. That the licensee did, on or about January 18, 2022, sell and/or deliver alcoholic liquor for resale to unauthorized persons/licenses in violation of the Neb. Rev. Stat. Sec. 53-176 of the Nebraska Liquor Control Act.
4. That the licensee did, on or about January 25, 2022, sell and/or deliver alcoholic liquor for resale to unauthorized persons/licenses in violation of the Neb. Rev. Stat. Sec. 53-176 of the Nebraska Liquor Control Act.
5. That the licensee did, on or about January 24, 2023, sell and/or deliver alcoholic liquor for resale to unauthorized persons/licenses in violation of the Neb. Rev. Stat. Sec. 53-176 of the Nebraska Liquor Control Act.
6. That the license should be suspended for a period of five (5) days, with the option to pay a penalty in lieu thereof.


IT IS THEREFORE CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Retail Class X Liquor License of Nebraska Distributing Company, DBA – “Premier Midwest Beverage Company”, 10367 S 134th St, Omaha, Nebraska, should be, and the same hereby is, suspended for a period of five (5) days, such suspension to commence at the closing hour of business on the 27th day of August 2023, and to continue until the opening hour of business on the 2nd day of September 2023, with the option to pay a penalty in lieu thereof.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the notice of suspension shall be posted upon the premises, said notice to remain posted throughout the term of said suspension.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Licensee shall pay costs of this action, assessed in the amount of \$0.00.
