Now on the 7th day of September, this matter came on for consideration before the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission, to show cause why the license should not be suspended, cancelled, or revoked for failure to comply with a specific Order of the Commission, i.e. training, as set forth in Commission Order dated August 25, 2015, in violation of 237-LCC1-005.01 of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.

In accordance with the Commission's policies, a proper notice of this hearing was sent by regular U.S. Mail.

The licensee was not present nor represented. The Commission was represented by Milissa Johnson-Wiles, Assistant Attorney General.

FINDINGS OF FACT:

1. That the licensee did fail to comply with a specific Order of the Commission, i.e. training, as set forth in Commission Order dated August 25th, 2015.

CONCLUSION OF LAW:

1. Failing to comply with a specific Order of the Commission is in violation of 237-LCC1-005.01 of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.
2. That the license should be cancelled.

IT IS THEREFORE CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Retail Class I Liquor License of Rodriguez Restaurante, dba "Premier Night Club", 111 E 6th Street, Lexington, Nebraska, should be, and the same hereby is, cancelled, effective at the closing hour of business on the 23rd day of October, 2016.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the licensee shall pay costs of this action, assessed in the amount of \$25.00.
