ORDER

Now on the 10th day of July 2019, this matter came on for consideration before the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission, notice having been served upon the licensee to appear and respond to an administrative citation alleging that the license should be suspended, cancelled or revoked as more fully set out herein.

The licensee was present. The Commission was represented by Milissa Johnson-Wiles, Assistant Attorney General.

Upon consideration of all the evidence in this case, the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission finds:  
FINDINGS OF FACT:

- 1. That the licensee did, on or about March 1, 2019, permit the selling, dispensing or giving away of alcoholic liquor, to or for an individual being less than 21 years of age.
- 2. That the licensee did, on or about March 1, 2019, permit a minor less than 19 years of age to sell or dispense alcoholic liquor, in and for said licensed premises.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

- 1. That permitting the selling, dispensing or giving away of alcoholic liquor, to or for an individual being less than 21 years of age, is in violation of Neb. Rev. Stat. Sec. 53-180 and/or 237-LCC6-019.01A of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.
- 2. That permitting a minor less than 19 years of age to sell or dispense alcoholic liquor, in and for said licensed premises, is in violation of Neb. Rev. Stat. Sec. 53-180.02 and Neb. Rev. Stat. Sec. 53-168.06(8).
- 3. That the license should be suspended for ten (10) days on charge #1 and suspended for ten (10) ten days on charge #2 for a total period of twenty (20) days, with the option to pay a fine in lieu thereof.
- 4. That the licensee and all staff shall complete an approved alcohol server training program within sixty (60) days from the date of this Order and shall show certification with complying with the provision of 237-LCC14-004 of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.

IT IS THEREFORE CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Retail Class I Liquor License of Slice LLC, DBA – “Pudgy's Pizzeria”, 16919 Audrey Street Suite 110, Omaha, Nebraska, should be, and the same hereby is, suspended for ten (10) days on charge #1 and suspended for ten (10) days on charge #2 for a total period of twenty (20) days, such suspension to commence at the closing hour of business on the 22nd day of September 2019, and to continue until the opening hour of business on the 13th day of October 2019, with the option to pay a fine in lieu thereof. Additionally, that the licensee and all staff shall complete an approved alcohol server training program within sixty (60) days from the date of this Order and shall show certification with complying with the provision of 237-LCC14-004 of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the notice of suspension shall be posted upon the premises, said notice to remain posted throughout the term of said suspension.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Licensee shall pay costs of this action, assessed in the amount of \$121.60.


