**AMENDED
ORDER**

Now on the 10th day of February, 2016, this matter came on for hearing before the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission, notice having been served upon the licensee to appear and respond to an administrative citation alleging that the license should be suspended, cancelled or revoked as more fully set out herein.

In accordance with the Commission's policies, a proper notice of this hearing was sent by U.S. regular mail.

The licensee was not present nor represented. The Commission was represented by Milissa Johnson-Wiles, Assistant Attorney General.

FINDINGS OF FACT:

1. That the licensed premises, on or about June 16, 2015, was found not to be maintained in a sanitary condition.
2. That the licensee/corporation failed to cause a new manager's application to be filed with the Commission within the required time.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

1. That failing to have the licensed premises maintained in a sanitary condition, is in violation of 237-LCC6-019.01S of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.
2. That failing to file a new manager's application within the required time, is in violation of 237-LCC2-009.01 of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.
3. That the license should be suspended for a period of thirty (30) days on charge 1 and suspended for a period of ten (10) days on charge 2 for a total forty (40) days suspension, with the option to pay a fine in lieu thereof.


IT IS THEREFORE CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Retail Class C-59756 Liquor License of 1515-23 Market Street Inc., dba "Quality Inn", located at 3200 NW 12 Street, Lincoln, Nebraska, should be, and the same hereby is, suspended for a period of thirty (30) days on charge 1 and suspended for ten (10) days on charge 2 for a total of forty (40) days suspension, such suspension to commence at the closing hour of business of the 15th day of May, 2016, and to continue until the opening hour of business on the 25th day of June, 2016.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the notice of suspension shall be posted upon the premises, said notice to remain posted throughout said suspension.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the licensee shall pay costs of this action, assessed in the amount of \$25.00.


