ORDER

Now on the 4th day of June 2019, this matter came on for consideration before the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission, notice having been served upon the licensee to appear and respond to an administrative citation alleging that the license should be suspended, cancelled or revoked as more fully set out herein.

Upon opening of the hearing, the licensee entered a plea of guilty to the charges.

Upon consideration of all the evidence in this case, the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission finds:

FINDING OF FACT:

1. That the licensee did not, on or about February 5th, 2019, sell or serve an unlimited quantity of alcoholic liquor at a special price, in violation of 237-LCC6-019.01U of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.
2. That the licensee failed or refused to comply with a specific order of the Commission as set forth-in Commission Order dated April 23rd, 2018, i.e., Licensee shall have no violations for one year.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

1. That failing or refusing to comply with a specific order of the Commission as set forth-in Commission Order dated April 23rd, 2018, i.e., Licensee shall have no violations for one year, is in violation of 237-LCC1-005.01 of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.
2. That the license should be suspended for a period of twenty (20) days, with the option to pay a fine in lieu thereof.
3. That a condition should be added to license of no violations for one (1) year from the date of this Order or License may be cancelled.

IT IS THEREFORE CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Retail Class CK Liquor License of Ronald Moore, DBA – “The Ridge”, 164 Main Street, Chadron, Nebraska, should be, and the same hereby is, suspended for a period of twenty (20) days, such suspension to commence at the closing hour of business on the 4th day of August 2019, and to continue until the opening hour of business on the 25th day of August 2019, with the option to pay a fine in lieu thereof. Additionally, that a condition should be added to license of no violations for one (1) year from the date of this Order or License may be cancelled.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the notice of suspension shall be posted upon the premises, said notice to remain posted throughout the term of said suspension.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Licensee shall pay costs of this action, assessed in the amount of \$25.00.
