**ORDER**

Now on the 4th day of August 2020, this matter came on for consideration before the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission, notice having been served upon the licensee to appear and respond to an administrative citation alleging that the license should be suspended, cancelled or revoked as more fully set out herein.

Upon consideration of all the evidence in this case, the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission finds: The licensee was present. The Commission was represented by Milissa Johnson-Wiles, Assistant Attorney General.

**FINDINGS OF FACT:**

1. That the licensee did, on or about February 23, 2020 permit open containers of alcoholic liquor to remain or to be in possession or control of persons for the purposes of consumption after 1:15 a.m.
2. That the licensee has allowed or permitted said spouse, namely, Donald Bonar, to work or otherwise participate in the licensed business contrary to the affidavit signed by Stephanie Bonar on March 16, 2018.

**CONCLUSION OF LAW:**

1. That permitting open containers of alcoholic liquor to remain or to be in possession or control of persons for the purposes of consumption after 1:15 a.m., is in violation of Neb. Rev. Stat. Sec. 53-179(3) and/or 237-LCC6-019.01D of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.
2. That allowing or permitting said spouse, namely, Donald Bonar, to work or otherwise participate in the licensed business contrary to the affidavit signed by Stephanie Bonar on March 16, 2018 is in violation of 237-LCC2-005.01B of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.
3. That the licensee should be suspended for five (5) days on charge #1 and suspended for forty (40) days on charge #2 for a total of forty-five (45) days, with the option to pay a fine in lieu thereof.
4. That Donald Bonar be banned and barred from the premises.
5. That a condition shall be added to the license of no violations on the premises for one (1) year from the date of this Order.

IT IS THEREFORE CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Retail Class C Liquor License of Stephanie Bonar, DBA – “The Rotten Apple Saloon”, 301 E 4th Corso, Nebraska City, Nebraska, should be, and the same hereby is, suspended for five (5) days on charge #1 and forty (40) days on charge #2 for a total period of forty-five (45) days, such suspension to commence at the closing hour of business on the 27th day of September 2020, and to continue until the opening hour of business on the 12th day of November 2020, with the option to pay a fine in lieu thereof. Additionally, that Donald Bonar be banned and barred from the premises and that a condition shall be added to the license of no violations on the premises for one (1) year from the date of this Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the notice of suspension shall be posted upon the premises, said notice to remain posted throughout the term of said suspension.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Licensee shall pay costs of this action, assessed in the amount of \$149.30.
