ORDER

Now on the 1st day of August 2023, this matter came on for consideration before the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission, the licensee having executed a voluntary appearance, waiver of public hearing, plea of guilty, and consent to judgment, in regard to the charge filed on the 13th day of June 2023.

Upon consideration of all the evidence in this case, the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission finds:

1. That the licensee did purchase, receive, acquire, accept, or possess alcoholic liquors from persons not authorized to sell to the licensee, in violation of Neb. Rev. Stat. Sec. 53-175.
2. That the license should be suspended for a period of ten (10) days, with the option to pay a penalty in lieu thereof.
3. That the licensee and all staff shall complete an approved alcohol server training program within sixty (60) days from the date of this Order and shall show certification with complying with the provision of 237-LCC14-004 of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.
4. That the alcohol seized during this investigation shall be destroyed by the Nebraska State Patrol in accordance with Neb. Rev. Stat. 53-1, 113.


IT IS THEREFORE CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Retail Class I Liquor License of Chaophraya LLC, DBA – “Sea Thai Restaurant/Bawarchi Indian Grill”, 17903 Pierce Plz, Omaha, Nebraska, should be, and the same hereby is, suspended for a period of ten (10) days, such suspension to commence at the closing hour of business on the 17th day of September 2023, and to continue until the opening hour of business on the 28th day of September 2023, with the option to pay a penalty in lieu thereof. Additionally, that the licensee and all staff shall complete an approved alcohol server training program within sixty (60) days from the date of this Order and shall show certification with complying with the provision of 237-LCC14-004 of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission. Furthermore, the alcohol seized during this investigation shall be destroyed by the Nebraska State Patrol in accordance with Neb. Rev. Stat. 53-1, 113.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the notice of suspension shall be posted upon the premises, said notice to remain posted throughout the term of said suspension.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Licensee shall pay costs of this action, assessed in the amount of \$0.00.


