Now on the 12th day of October 2016, this matter came on for consideration before the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission, to show cause why the license should not be cancelled, or revoked due to the sales tax permit of the aforementioned business having been suspended by the Nebraska Department of Revenue effective July 14, 2016.

In accordance with the Commission's policies, a proper notice of this hearing was sent by regular U.S. Mail.

The licensee was not present nor represented. The Commission was represented by Milissa Johnson-Wiles, Assistant Attorney General.

Based upon the testimony of the witness and the evidence in this case, The Commission finds the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT:

- 1. That the licensee's sale's tax permit of the aforementioned business has been suspended since July 14, 2016.

CONCLUSION OF LAW:

- 1. That the license should be cancelled.

IT IS THEREFORE CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Retail Class C Liquor License of Dennis Nelson, dba "Sportsman's Bar", 501 N Pine Street, Gran Island, Nebraska, should be, and the same hereby is, cancelled, effective at the closing hour of business on the 20th day of November, 2016.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the licensee shall pay costs of this action, assessed in the amount of \$25.00.
