Now on the 6<sup>th</sup> day of July 2022, this matter came on for hearing before the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission, an order to show cause why the license should not be cancelled or revoked due to the sales tax permit of the aforementioned business having been suspended by the Nebraska Department of Revenue effective January 13, 2022.

In accordance with the Commission's policies, a proper notice of this hearing was sent by regular U.S. Mail.

The licensee was not present nor represented. The Commission was represented by Milissa Johnson-Wiles, Assistant Attorney General.

Upon consideration of all the evidence in this case, the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission finds:

FINDINGS OF FACT:

1. That the licensee's sales tax permit is suspended by the Nebraska Department of Revenue.
2. Evidence showed that the licensee was operating while the sales tax permit was suspended.

CONCLUSION OF LAW:

1. That the license shall be cancelled.


IT IS THEREFORE CONSIDERED, ORDERED, MTE LLC", Sportman's Bar, 501 N Pine Street, Grand Island, Nebraska, should be, and the same hereby is, cancelled, effective at the closing hour of business on the 21<sup>st</sup> day of August 2022.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the licensee shall pay costs of this action, assessed in the amount of \$35.00. Additionally, that the licensee shall pay costs of \$35.00 from June hearing and order dated June 13, 2022 for a total due of \$70.00.
