No person shall within said Village sell at retail any alcoholic liquors, including beer on the day of any national, state, county, or municipal election, including primary elections, during the hours the polls are open in said Village. No person shall within said Village sell at retail any alcoholic liquors, including beer, on the first day of the week commonly called Sunday between the hours of twelve (12) o'clock midnight Saturday and six (6) o'clock a.m. Monday. No person shall within said Village sell at retail any alcoholic liquors, including beer, on secular days between twelve (12) o'clock midnight and six (6) o'clock a.m."
