ORDER

Now on the 10th day of July 2019, this matter came on for consideration before the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission, this matter came on for consideration before the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission, notice having been served upon the licensee to appear and respond to an administrative citation alleging that the license should be suspended, cancelled or revoked as more fully set out herein.

In accordance with the Commission’s policies, a proper notice of this hearing was sent by regular U.S. Mail.

The licensee was not present nor represented. The Commission was represented by Milissa Johnson-Wiles, Assistant Attorney General.

FINDINGS OF FACT:

- 1. That the licensee did, purchase alcoholic liquor from Republic National Distributing Company and did accept merchandising credit thereupon for a period exceeding thirty days.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

- 1. That purchasing alcoholic liquor from Republic National Distributing Company and did accept merchandising credit thereupon for a period exceeding thirty days, is in violation of Neb. Rev. Stat. Sec. 53-168 and/or 237-LCC6-019.01K and 237-LCC6-018.01A of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.
- 2. That the license should be suspended for a period of five (5) days, with the option to pay a fine in lieu thereof.
- 3. That an Order to Show Cause hearing should be set before the Commission to determine if the license should be cancelled or revoked for failure to failure to operate for thirty (30) continuous days or sixty (60) total days, in violation of 237-LCC6-020.03 of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.

IT IS THEREFORE CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Retail Class C Liquor License of Steak and Vine Inc, DBA – “Steak and Grapes”, 16920 Wright Plaza, Suite 118, Omaha, Nebraska, should be, and the same hereby is, suspended for a period of five (5) days, such suspension to commence at the closing hour of business on the 25th day of August 2019, and to continue until the opening hour of business on the 31st day of August 2019, with the option to pay a fine in lieu thereof. Additionally, That an Order to Show Cause hearing should be set before the Commission to determine if the license should be cancelled or revoked for failure to failure to operate for thirty (30) continuous days or sixty (60) total days, in violation of 237-LCC6-020.03 of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission. Such hearing to be held on Wednesday, August 7th, 2019 @ 9:00 A.M. or as soon thereafter as it may be heard on the first floor of the State Office Building, located at 301 Centennial Mall South, Lincoln, Nebraska.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the notice of suspension shall be posted upon the premises, said notice to remain posted throughout the term of said suspension.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Licensee shall pay costs of this action, assessed in the amount of \$100.68.


