ORDINANCE NO. 989

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SYRACUSE, OTOE COUNTY, NEBRASKA TO AMEND CHAPTER 10, ARTICLE 1 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE TO CHANGE THE HOURS THAT ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR, INCLUDING BEER, MAY BE SOLD; TO PROVIDE FOR THE REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES OR SECTIONS; AND TO PROVIDE FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SYRACUSE, OTOE COUNTY, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. That Chapter 10, Article 1, Section 10-107 of the Municipal Code of the City of Syracuse, Otoe County, Nebraska be amended to read as follows:

ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES; HOURS OF SALE

1. For the purposes of this Ordinance, "on sale" shall be defined as alcoholic beverages sold at retail by the drink for consumption on the premises of the licensed establishment. "Off sale" shall be defined as alcoholic beverages sold at retail in the original container for consumption off the premises of the licensed establishment.
2. It shall be unlawful for any licensed person or persons or their agents to sell any alcoholic beverages within the municipality except during the hours provided herein:

HOURS OF SALE

Alcoholic Liquor (except beer and wine)

Days, other than Sundays

Off Sale . . . 6:00 A.M. to 1:00 A.M.

On Sale . . . 6:00 A.M. to 2:00 A.M.

Sundays

Off Sale 12 Noon to 1:00 A.M.

On Sale 12 Noon to 2:00 A.M.

Beer and Wine

Days, other than Sundays

Off Sale . . . 6:00 A.M. to 1:00 A.M.

On Sale . . . 6:00 A.M. to 2:00 A.M.

Sundays

Off Sale . . . 6:00 A.M. to 1:00 A.M.

On Sale . . . 6:00 A.M. to 2:00 A.M.

Provided that such limitations shall not apply after 12:00 Noon on Sunday to a licensee which is a nonprofit corporation holding a Class C license or a Class I license.


3. No person or persons shall consume any alcoholic beverage on licensed premises for a period of time longer than fifteen minutes after the time fixed herein for stopping the sale of alcoholic beverages on the said premises.
4. Nothing in this section shall be construed to prohibit licensed premises from being open for other business on days and hours during which the sale or dispensing of alcoholic beverages is prohibited by this Section. (Ref. 53-179 RS Neb.)

Section 2. Any person violating any provision of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction, be subject to a fine of not more than \$100.00 for each offense.

Section 3. Any ordinances or sections passed and approved prior to the passage, approval and publication or posting of this ordinance and in conflict with its provisions are hereby repealed.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage, approval, and publication or posting as required by law commencing Thursday, May 19th, 2016.

ORDINANCE PASSAGE PROCEEDINGS

Council member Gigstad introduced Ordinance No. 989
entitled:


and moved that the statutory rule requiring reading on three different days be suspended. Council member Henke seconded the motion to suspend the rules and upon roll call on the motion, the following Council members voted YEA: Britton, Henke, Dettmer, Gigstad. The following voted NAY: None. The motion to suspend the rules was adopted by three-fourths of the City Council, and the statutory rule was declared suspended for consideration of said ordinance.

Said ordinance was then read by title, and thereafter Council member Dettmer moved for final passage of the ordinance which motion was seconded by Council member Gigstad. The Mayor then stated the question, "Shall Ordinance No. 989 be passed and adopted?" Upon roll call vote, the following Council members voted YEA: Henke, Gigstad, Dettmer, Britton. The following voted NAY: None. The passage and adoption of said ordinance, having been concurred in by a majority of all members of the City Council, the Mayor declared the ordinance adopted, and the Mayor in the presence of the City Council, signed and approved the ordinance, and the Clerk attested the passage and approval of the same and affixed her signature thereto.


