ORDER

Now on the 16th day of December 2015, this matter came on for consideration before the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission, notice having been served upon the licensee to appear and respond to an administrative citation alleging that the license should be suspended, cancelled or revoked as more fully set out herein.

In accordance with the commission's policies, a proper notice of this hearing was sent by regular mail. The licensee was not present nor represented. The Commission was represented by Milissa Johnson-Wiles, Assistant Attorney General.

Based upon the testimony of the witness and the evidence in this case, the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission finds the following:

FINDINGS OF FACTS:

- 1. That the licensee did purchase, receive, acquire, accept or possess alcoholic liquors from persons not authorized to sell to the licensee.

CONCLUSION OF LAW:

- 2. That the said purchase, receiving, acquiring, accepting or possessing of alcoholic liquors from persons not authorized to sell to the licensee is in direct violation of Section 53-175 of the Nebraska Statutes and/or 237-LCC6-010.01 of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.
- 3. That the license should be suspended for a period of eight (8) day(s), with the option to pay a fine in lieu thereof.

IT IS THEREFORE CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Retail Class I Liquor License of Thai Orchids LLC, DBA – Thai Orchids Restaurant, 8058 S 84th Street, La Vista, Nebraska, should be, and the same hereby is, suspended for a period of eight (8) day(s), such suspension to commence at the closing hour of business on the 20th day of March 2016, and to continue until the opening hour of business on the 29th day of March 2016.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the notice of suspension shall be posted upon the premises, said notice to remain posted throughout the term of said suspension.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the licensee shall pay costs of this action, assessed in the amount of \$25.00.
