Now on the 10th day of February, 2016, this matter came on for hearing before the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission upon an order to show cause why the license should not be suspended, cancelled or revoked for failure to pay hearing costs of \$24.00 assessed in Commission Order dated October 6, 2015, in violation of 237-LCC1-008 of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.

In accordance with the Commission's policies, a proper notice of this hearing was sent by U.S. Regular Mail.

The licensee was not present nor represented. The State was represented by Milissa Johnson-Wiles, Assistant Attorney General.

Upon consideration of all the evidence in this matter, the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission finds the following:

1. That the licensee failed to pay hearing costs in the amount of \$24.00 assessed in Commission Order dated October 6, 2015, in violation of 237-LCC1-008 of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.
2. That the licensee shall pay the outstanding costs of \$24.00 assessed in Commission Order dated October 6, 2015.
3. That the license should be suspended for twenty (20) days, with the option to pay a fine in lieu thereof.
4. That the licensee shall pay costs of \$25.00 assessed from this hearing before the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission on February 10, 2016, as stated in this Order.
5. That the total hearing costs in the amount of \$49.00 shall be paid to the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.


IT IS THEREFORE CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Class C Liquor License of Tienda Leon Inc., dba "Tienda Leon", 116-118 Norfolk Avenue, Norfolk, Nebraska, should be, and the same hereby is, suspended for a period of twenty (20) days, such suspension to commence at the closing hour of business on the 22nd day of May, 2016, and to continue until the opening hour of business on the 12th day of June, 2016, with the option to pay a fine in lieu thereof. Additionally, that the licensee is responsible to pay outstanding hearing costs of \$24.00 assessed in Commission Order dated October 6, 2015, as well as, hearing costs of \$25.00 assessed in this Order; said hearing costs totaling the amount of \$49.00.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the licensee shall pay costs of this action, assessed in the amount of \$25.00.


