Now on the 14th day of January, 2016, this matter came on for hearing before the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission, notice having been served upon the licensee to appear and respond to an administrative citation alleging that the license should be suspended, cancelled or revoked as more fully set out herein.

The licensee was present and represented by attorney Michael Tasset. The Commission was represented by Milissa Johnson-Wiles, Assistant Attorney General.

FINDINGS OF FACT:

1. That the licensee did, on or about September 1, 2015, allow or permit a disturbance and/or illegal activities, i.e., improper force with patron/use of a weapon, in or about the licensed premise.

CONCLUSION OF LAW:

1. That allowing or permitting a disturbance and/or illegal activities, i.e., improper force with patron/use of a weapon, in or about the licensed premise, is in direct violation of 237-LCC6-019.01F of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.
2. That the license should be suspended for a period of twenty (20) days.
3. That there shall be no violations at the premise for one (1) year from the date of this order.


IT IS THEREFORE CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Retail Class C-110656 Liquor License of David W Tuberville, dba "Tubes", 223 N Market, Shickley, Nebraska, should be, and the same hereby is, suspended for twenty (20) days, such suspension to commence at the closing hour of business on the 10th day of April, 2016, and to continue until the opening hour of business on the 1st day of May, 2016. Furthermore, that there shall be no violations at the premise for one (1) year from the date of this order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the notice of suspension shall be posted upon the premises, said notice to remain posted throughout the term of said suspension.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the licensee shall pay costs of this action, assessed in the amount of \$199.28.
