Now on the 5th day of April 2022, this matter came on for hearing before the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission, an order to show cause in violation of Neb. Rev. Stat. Sec. 53-131.01 of the Nebraska Liquor Control Act, i.e., Luis Jacobo failed to disclose:

- 4/2021- Driving under suspension
- 5/2020- Failure to appear

In accordance with the Commission's policies, a proper notice of this hearing was sent by regular U.S. Mail.

The licensee was not present nor represented. The Commission was represented by Milissa Johnson-Wiles, Assistant Attorney General.

FINDINGS OF FACT:

1. That the licensee did file a false renewal.

CONCLUSION OF LAW:

1. That filing a false renewal is in violation of Neb. Rev. Stat. Sec. 53-131.01 of the Nebraska Liquor Control Act.
2. That the license shall be cancelled.

IT IS THEREFORE CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Retail Class C Liquor License of Luis Jacobo, dba "Tucan Tacos", 2120 N Webb Road, Grand Island, Nebraska, should be, and the same hereby is, cancelled, effective at the closing hour of business on the 15th day of May 2022.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Licensee shall pay costs of this action, assessed in the amount of \$35.00.
