ORDER

Now on the 5th day of March 2019, this matter came on for hearing before the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission upon an order to show cause why the license should not be suspended, cancelled, or revoked for failure to comply with a specific Order of the Commission, i.e., failure to complete training, as set forth in Commission Order dated September 20th, 2018, in violation of 237-LCC1-005.01 of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.

The licensee was present. The Commission was represented by Milissa Johnson-Wiles, Assistant Attorney General.

Upon consideration of all the evidence in this case, the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission finds:

1. That the licensee did, fail to comply with a specific Order of the Commission, i.e., failure to complete training, as set forth in Commission Order dated September 20th, 2018, in violation of 237-LCC1-005.01 of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.
2. That the license should be suspended for a period of twenty (20) days, with the option to pay a fine in lieu thereof.
3. That the licensee and all staff shall complete an approved alcohol server training program within thirty (30) days from the date of this Order and shall show certification with complying with the provision of 237-LCC14-004 of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission or the license shall be cancelled.

IT IS THEREFORE CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Retail Class CK Liquor License of Jared A Rodger, DBA – "Uncle Jarrol's Pub-B-Que", 2610 W Norfolk Avenue, Norfolk, Nebraska, should be, and the same hereby is, suspended for twenty (20) days closing hour of business on the 5th day of May 2019, and to continue until the opening hour of business on the 26th day of May 2019, with the option to pay a fine in lieu thereof. Furthermore, the licensee and all staff shall complete an approved alcohol server training program within thirty (30) days from the date of this Order and shall show certification with complying with the provision of 237-LCC14-004 of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission or the license shall be cancelled.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the notice of suspension shall be posted upon the premises, said notice to remain posted throughout the term of said suspension.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Licensee shall pay costs of this action, assessed in the amount of \$25.00.
