ORDER

Now on the 15th day of March 2016, this matter came on for consideration before the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission, notice having been served upon the licensee to appear and respond to an administrative citation alleging that the license should be suspended, cancelled or revoked as more fully set out herein.

Upon consideration of all the evidence in this case, the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission finds:

- 4. That the licensee did, on or about February 27, 2016, permit the selling, dispensing or giving away of alcoholic liquor, to or for an individual being less than 21 years of age, in violation of Neb. Rev. Stat. Sec. 53-180 and/or 237-LCC6-019.01A of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.
- 5. That the license should be suspended for a period of seven (7) days, with the option to pay a fine in lieu thereof.
- 6. That the licensee and all staff shall complete an approved alcohol server training program within sixty (60) days from the date of this Order and shall show certification with complying with the provision of 237-LCC14-004 of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.

IT IS THEREFORE CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Retail Class C Liquor License of Veterans F W Post 3113, DBA – “Veterans FW 3113”, 2337 N K St., Fairbury, Nebraska, should be, and the same hereby is, suspended for a period of seven (7) days, such suspension to commence at the closing hour of business on the 26th day of June 2016, and to continue until the opening hour of business on the 4th day of July 2016, with the option to pay a fine in lieu thereof. Additionally, that the licensee and all staff shall complete an approved alcohol server training program within sixty (60) days from the date of this Order and shall show certification with complying with the provision of 237-LCC14-004 of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the notice of suspension shall be posted upon the premises, said notice to remain posted throughout the term of said suspension.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Licensee shall pay costs of this action, assessed in the amount of \$0.00.



IMPORTANT - PLEASE READ

To Licensee:

The Order of suspension, to which this Notice is enclosed, provides for a suspension of your license for a period of **seven** days. State Law provides that you may either comply with the Order of suspension and be closed for the prescribed number of days or you may notify the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission and elect to pay a fine of **\$50** per day for the number of days of your suspension and remain open and continue the full operation of your establishment.

If you desire to pay a fine instead of being closed you must sign the below election notification request and mail it to the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission, P.O. Box 95046, Lincoln, Nebraska 68509, along with a certified or cashier's check, personal or business check, or U.S. money order made payable to the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission; the election notification must be received by the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission on or before **20th day of June, 2016**; if the election notification and full payment is not received by the above stated date then you must close your establishment for the sale of alcoholic liquor for the required number of days suspended.

GUIDELINES FOR COMMISSION ORDERED TRAINING

As the result of a Nebraska Liquor Control Commission (NLCC) Hearing and per the enclosed Order, **the licensee(s), all employees and management**, who may be called upon to sell or serve alcohol, are required to complete a NLCC Certified Alcohol Server Training Program **and register** this training with our office within **60 days of the date of the order**.

You are also required to submit a list of all staff that serve and/or sell alcohol in your establishment via e-mail to david.kirwan@nebraska.gov or fax to (402) 471-2814 or by mail **within 30 days of the date of the order**.

If the required information is not received in our office by the end of the 60 day period, your file will be forwarded to our Legal Division for further action before the Commission, resulting in possible suspension/fine, cancellation or revocation of your liquor license and additional hearing costs.

You are responsible for:

- **Making your own arrangements with and completing one (1) of the programs on the attached list.**
- **Submitting a photocopy of the "Certificate of Achievement", "Certificate of Course Completion", "Certificate of Completion" or similar documentation received from the program to our office.**
(Provide your Liquor License number to assure proper processing!)
AND
- **Remitting payment of a processing fee of \$10.00 per certificate.**

The Commission has defined "**all employees**" to mean anyone who, in the course of their duties, **MAY** be called upon to serve or sell alcohol products or check ID's. This typically would include: all management team members, hosts or hostesses, wait staff, bar tenders, security & door personnel, cashiers, etc. and possibly bus staff.

Employees who would **NEVER** be in the position of selling or serving alcohol do not need to be included in your list of employees. This might be kitchen staff (cooks, prep-staff, dishwashers and, again, possibly bus staff), retail stockers, customer service staff and check out baggers (provided they never act as cashiers), etc.

Training completed within the last 3 years does not have to be repeated (but it is recommended), **however** the training will need to be registered with our office if not previously submitted.

If the licensee or employee has a NLCC Training Certification, issued within the last 3 years, they do not need to be re-certified with our office, however repeat training is recommended as a refresher and reminder.
