ORDER

Now on the 7th day of June 2022, this matter came on for hearing before the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission, an order to show cause why the license should not be suspended, cancelled, or revoked due to violation of Commission Order dated 7/16/2021, i.e., that there will be no alcohol violations both personal and on premises for one (1) year, i.e., premises sold to a minor during a compliance check on 8/27/2021, in violation of 237-LCC1-005.01 of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Act.

The licensee was present and represented by Attorney Robert Black. The Commission was represented by Milissa Johnson-Wiles, Assistant Attorney General.

Upon consideration of all the evidence in this case, the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission finds:
FINDINGS OF FACT:

1. That the licensee did violate the Commission Order dated 7/16/2021, i.e., that there will be no alcohol violations both personal and on premises for one (1) year, i.e., premises sold to a minor during a compliance check on 8/27/2021.

CONCLUSION OF LAW:

1. That violating Commission Order dated 7/16/2021, i.e., that there will be no alcohol violations both personal and on premises for one (1) year, i.e., premises sold to a minor during a compliance check on 8/27/2021, is in violation of 237-LCC1-005.01 of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Act.
2. That the license should be suspended for a period of thirty (30) days, with the option to pay a fine in lieu thereof.

IT IS THEREFORE CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Retail Class IK Liquor License of TDS Enterprises LLC, DBA – “Villagio Pizzeria”, 6922 N 102nd Circle, Omaha, Nebraska, should be, and the same hereby is, suspended for a period of thirty (30) days, such suspension to commence at the closing hour of business on the 11th day of September 2022, and to continue until the opening hour of business on the 12th day of October 2022, with the option to pay a fine in lieu thereof.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the notice of suspension shall be posted upon the premises, said notice to remain posted throughout the term of said suspension.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Licensee shall pay costs of this action, assessed in the amount of \$35.00.
