ORDER

Now on the 6th day of September 2023, this matter came on for consideration before the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission, notice having been served upon the licensee to appear and respond to an administrative citation alleging that the license should be suspended, cancelled or revoked as more fully set out herein.

The licensee was present and represented by Attorney Sean Kelley. The Commission was represented by Ken Yoho, Assistant Attorney General.

A plea of guilty was given upon opening.

Upon consideration of all the evidence in this case, the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission finds:

FINDING OF FACT:

- 1. That the licensee did, on or about May 5, 2023, permit the selling, dispensing or giving away of alcoholic liquor, to or for an individual being less than 21 years of age.

CONCLUSION OF LAW:

- 1. That the licensee did, on or about May 5, 2023, permit the selling, dispensing or giving away of alcoholic liquor, to or for an individual being less than 21 years of age, in violation of Neb. Rev. Stat. Sec. 53-180 and/or 237-LCC6-019.01A of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.
- 2. That the license shall be suspended for a mandatory period of five (5) days and that the license should be suspended for an additional twenty (20) days, with the option to pay a penalty in lieu thereof.
- 3. That the licensee and all staff shall complete an approved alcohol server training program within sixty (60) days from the date of this Order and shall show certification with complying with the provision of 237-LCC14-004 of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.

IT IS THEREFORE CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Retail Class C Liquor License of VooDoo Taco Gretna LLC DBA – “VooDoo Taco”, 21407 Neb. Crossing Dr, Ste J 13, Gretna, Nebraska, should be, and the same hereby is, suspended for a period of five (5) mandatory closure days and suspended an additional twenty (20) days, with the option to pay a penalty in lieu thereof, such mandatory closure to be October 23rd, 2023, thru October 27th, 2023; and the additional twenty (20) day suspension to commence on October 28th 2023, and to continue until the opening hour of business on the 17th day of November 2023. Additionally, that the licensee and all staff shall complete an approved alcohol server training program within sixty (60) days from the date of this Order and shall show certification with complying with the provision of 237-LCC14-004 of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the notice of suspension shall be posted upon the premises, said notice to remain posted throughout the term of said suspension.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Licensee shall pay costs of this action, assessed in the amount of \$144.88.


