

IMPORTANT RENEWAL PUBLICATION NOTICE

CLERK RE: Class C liquor license holders

As clerk, you are responsible to fulfill the renewal notice requirements as set forth in sec. §53-135.01 of the Liquor Control Act. Publication shall be made one time between July 10 and 30 in a legal newspaper in or of general circulation in your city, village or county. **You are not required to file a copy of this notice with the Liquor Commission.**

Renewal forms will be mailed to you the first week of August to copy for your file and distribute to your class C liquor license holders. Please encourage licensees to renew promptly and use the **ON-LINE RENEWAL OPTION.**

If a liquor license has not been picked up within twenty-one days (November 21), you must return the license to the Liquor Commission.

The NLCC is excited to announce an expanded on-line renewal option which will allow licensees to pay local fees along with state fees. Contact our office if you wish to participate or have questions.
