ORDER

Now on the 15th day of July 2015, this matter came on for consideration before the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission, notice having been served upon the licensee to appear and respond to an administrative citation alleging that the license should be suspended, cancelled or revoked as more fully set out herein.

The licensee was present and represented by Michael Kelley, Attorney. The State was represented by Milissa Johnson-Wiles, Assistant Attorney General.

Upon opening of the hearing, the licensee entered a plea of guilty to the charge.

Upon consideration of all the evidence in this case, the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission finds:

1. That the licensee did, on or about December 12, 2014, permit the selling, dispensing, or giving away of alcoholic liquor, to or for an individual being less than 21 years of age, in violation of Neb. Rev. Stat. Sec. 53-180 and/or 237-LCC6-019.01A of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.
2. That the license shall be suspended for a mandatory period of two (2) days and that the license should be suspended for an additional thirty (30) days, with the option to pay a fine in lieu thereof.

IT IS THEREFORE CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Retail Class CK Liquor License of Chrysler Café Inc., DBA – “Olympic Lounge/Whiskey Tango”, 1419-1421 Farnam Street, Omaha, Nebraska, should be, and the same hereby is, suspended for a period of two (2) mandatory closure days and suspended an additional thirty (30) days, with the option to pay a fine in lieu thereof, such mandatory closure to be October 5, 2015 and October 6, 2015; and the additional thirty (30) day suspension to commence at the closing hour of business on the 5th day of October 2015, and to continue until the opening hour of business on the 6th day of November 2015.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the notice of suspension shall be posted upon the premises, said notice to remain posted throughout the term of said suspension.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the licensee shall pay costs of this action, assessed in the amount of \$25.00.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the state shall pay costs of this action, assessed in the amount of \$119.75.
