ORDER

Now on the 15th day of July, 2015, this matter came on for consideration before the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission, the licensee having executed a voluntary appearance, waiver of public hearing, plea of guilty, and consent to judgment, in regard to the charge filed on the 12th day of June, 2015.

Upon consideration of all the evidence in this case, the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission finds:

1. That the licensee did, on or about February 13, 2015, permit or knowingly allow conduct on or about the licensed premise in violation of 237-LCC6-019.01Q of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission, i.e., gambling.


2. That the license should be suspended for a period of five (5) day(s).

IT IS THEREFORE CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Retail Class C Liquor License of American Legion 124, dba American Legion 124, 1339 Center Avenue, Mitchell NE, should be, and the same hereby is, suspended for a period of five (5) day(s), such suspension to commence at the closing hour of business on the 13th day of September, 2015, and to continue until the opening hour of business on the 19th day of September, 2015.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the notice of suspension shall be posted upon the premises, said notice to remain posted throughout the term of said suspension.


