ORDER

Now on the 15th day of July, 2015, this matter came on for hearing before the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission, notice having been served upon the licensee to appear and respond to an administrative citation alleging that the license should be suspended, cancelled or revoked as more fully set out herein.

The licensee was present and represented by attorney Timothy Krajicek. The Commission was represented by Milissa Johnson-Wiles, Assistant Attorney General.

**FINDINGS OF FACT:**

1. That the licensee did, on or about April 9, 2015, permit the selling, dispensing, or giving away of alcoholic liquor, to an individual being less than 21 years of age.

**CONCLUSION OF LAW:**

1. That the said sale of alcoholic liquor to a person under the age of twenty-one (21) is in direct violation of Section 53-180 of the Nebraska Statutes and/or 237-LCC6-019.01A of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.
2. That the license should be suspended for two (2) days of mandatory closure, and suspended for an additional fifty (50) days, with the option to pay a fine in lieu thereof.


IT IS THEREFORE CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Retail Class B-23236 Liquor License of West Mart Inc., dba "West Mart", 11202 Richland Drive, Papillion, Nebraska, should be, and the same hereby is suspended for two (2) days of mandatory closure, and suspended for an additional fifty (50) days, with the option to pay a fine in lieu thereof, such mandatory closure to be October 12 & 13, 2015; and the additional fifty (50) days suspension to commence at the closing hour of business on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of October, 2015, and to continue until the opening hour of business on the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of December, 2015.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the notice of suspension shall be posted upon the premises, and notice to remain posted throughout the term or said suspension.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the licensee shall pay costs of this action, assessed in the amount of \$173.33.


