ORDER

Now on the 28th day of July 2015, this matter came on for hearing before the Hearing Officer appointed by the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission pursuant to 237-LCC1-002.14 of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission, the licensee having executed a voluntary appearance, waiver of public hearing, plea of guilty, and consent to judgment, in regard to the charge filed on the 9th of June, 2015.

Upon consideration of all the evidence in this case, the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission finds:

1. That the licensee did file a renewal for license after the date prescribed by law, in violation of 53-135 of the Nebraska Statutes and/or 237-LCC1-008 of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.
2. That the license should be suspended for two (2) days.

IT IS THEREFORE CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Class S Liquor License of Wstrn Spirits Bvrge Co LLC, DBA - Western Spirits, 1250 Northwest St, Wilson, WY shall pay a fine in the amount of \$200.00. Mandatory payment of fine in lieu of suspension is ordered under Nebraska Revised Statute 53-1,104(6).
