ORDER

Now on the 19th day of August 2015, this matter came on for consideration before the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission, the licensee having executed a voluntary appearance, waiver of public hearing, plea of guilty, and consent to judgment, in regard to the charge filed on the 23rd day of July 2015.

Upon consideration of all the evidence in this case, the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission finds:

1. That the licensee did, on or about March 15, 2015 sell, dispense, furnish or allow possession of alcoholic liquor to an individual who had become intoxicated by the previous consumption of alcoholic liquor, in violation of 237-LCC6-019.01N of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.
2. That the license should be suspended for a period of ten (10) days, with the option to pay a fine in lieu thereof.
3. That the licensee and all staff shall complete an approved alcohol server training program within sixty (60) days from the date of this Order and shall show certification with complying with the provision of 237-LCC14-004 of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.


IT IS THEREFORE CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Retail Class D Liquor License of Hy-Vee Inc., dba "Hy-Vee Gas", 250 N 52nd Street, Lincoln, Nebraska, should be, and the same hereby is, suspended for a period of ten (10) days, such suspension to commence at the closing hour of business on the 11th day of October 2015, and to continue until the opening hour of business on the 22nd day of October 2015, with the option to pay a fine in lieu thereof. Additionally, that the licensee and all staff shall complete an approved alcohol server training program within sixty (60) days from the date of this Order and shall show certification with complying with the provision of 237-LCC14-004 of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the notice of suspension shall be posted upon the premises, said notice to remain posted throughout the term of said suspension.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the licensee shall pay costs of this action, assessed in the amount of \$0.00.
