**ORDER**

Now on the 15th day of July, 2015, this matter came on for consideration before the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission, the licensee having executed a voluntary appearance, waiver of public hearing, plea of guilty, and consent to judgment, in regard to the charge filed on the 15th day of May, 2015.

Upon consideration of all the evidence in this case, the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission finds:

1. That the licensee did, on or about May 15, 2015, permit open containers of alcoholic liquor to remain or to be in possession or control of persons for the purposes of consumption after 1:15 a.m., in violation of Neb. Rev. Stat. Sec. 53-179(3) and/or 237-LCC6-019.01D of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.


2. That the license should be suspended for a period of ten (10) day(s).

IT IS THEREFORE CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Retail Class I Liquor License of Luisa Lovato, dba Ritmos Nightclub, 611 E 4 Street, Grand Island NE, should be, and the same hereby is, suspended for a period of ten (10) day(s), such suspension to commence at the closing hour of business on the 13th day of September, 2015, and to continue until the opening hour of business on the 24th day of September, 2015.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the notice of suspension shall be posted upon the premises, said notice to remain posted throughout the term of said suspension.


