Now on the 23rd day of September, 2015, this matter came on for hearing before the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission upon an order to show cause why the license should not be suspended, cancelled or revoked for failure to pay hearing costs of \$25.00 assessed in Commission Order dated May 22, 2015, in violation of 237-LCC1-008 of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.

The licensee was present. The Commission was represented by Milissa Johnson-Wiles, Assistant Attorney General.

THE COMMISSION FINDS:


1. That the licensee failed to pay hearing costs in the amount of \$25.00 assessed in Commission Order dated May 22, 2015, in violation of 237-LCC1-008 of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.
2. That the licensee shall pay the outstanding costs of \$25.00 assessed in Commission Order dated May 22, 2015.
3. That the licensee shall pay costs of \$25.00 assessed from this hearing of September 23, 2015, as stated in this Order.
4. That the total amount of \$50.00 in hearings costs shall be paid within thirty (30) days from the date of this Order.
5. That the license should be suspended for a period of two (2) days suspension, with the option to pay a fine in lieu thereof.

IT IS THEREFORE CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Class C Liquor License of Elite Lounge & Grille Inc., dba "Rehab Lounge, 2615 S 120 Street, Omaha, Nebraska, should be, and the same hereby is, responsible to pay assessed hearing costs in the total amount of \$50.00 within thirty (30) days from the date of this Order. Furthermore, that the license should be suspended for two (2) days suspension, with the option to pay a fine in lieu thereof; such suspension to commence at the closing hour of business on the 15th day of November, 2015, and to continue until the opening hour of business on the 18th day of November, 2015.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the notice of suspension shall be posted upon the premises, said notice to remain posted throughout the term of said suspension.


