Now on the 19th day of August, 2015, this matter came on for hearing before the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission upon an order to show cause why the license should not be suspended, cancelled or revoked for failure to submit a new manager's application, in violation of 237-LCC2-009 of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.

In accordance with the Commission's policies, a proper notice of this hearing was sent by regular U.S. mail.

The licensee was not present nor represented. The Commission was represented by Milissa Johnson-Wiles, Assistant Attorney General.

Upon consideration of the all the evidence in this matter, the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission finds:


1. That the licensee failed to file a new manager's application within sixty (60) days, which is in violation of 237-LCC2-009 of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.
2. That the license should be cancelled.

IT IS THEREFORE CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Retail Class I Liquor License of White Elephant LLC, dba "Mai Thai II", located at 2279 S 67 Street, Suite B, Omaha, Nebraska, should be, and the same hereby is, cancelled, effective at the closing hour of business on the 18th day of October, 2015.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the licensee shall pay costs of this action, assessed in the amount of \$25.00.


